



Internal Communications	'An organisation's managed communication system, where employees are regarded as internal public' (Vercic et al, 2012 in: Tench & Waddington, 2022)
	Two-way symmetrical communication results in 'open, trusting, and credible relationships with strategic employee groups following' (Grunig, 1992 in: Tench & Waddington, 2022)

- No organisation can thrive without robust IC








IC: function & characteristics


